

Digital Dunes Golf League

Single / Multiple location(s)

Minimum 4 teams Maximum 8 teams per "Season"

Season will last 6 weeks with 6 different courses.

Season One: January 20th - February 24th

Match Day will contain a number of Games that will be scheduled within the time window. Each Game is estimated to take 2 hours. No team will play more than one (1) Game on a Match Day.

- A vs B
- C vs D
- E vs F

Each Game:

- TRIPLES: 3v3 alternating shot playing the first 9 holes from the designated golf course.
- SINGLES: 1v1 between players for holes 10,11,12,13,14,15 from the designated golf course

Hole scored:

- One (1) point for each hole win
- Zero (0) point for tying the hole

If the teams are tied at the end of the match, the remaining holes [16-18] will be used in sudden death overtime, played in the TRIPLES format. First team to win a hole, wins the game. If neither team has won after 18 holes. A draw is called and neither team will be awarded match point(s) and only awarded Overtime appearance of 1 point.

Game scored:

- Two (2) points for each win
- Losing team is awarded One (1) point for playing into overtime
- Both teams awarded One (1) point if tied after all holes are played
- Zero (0) points for regulation loss.

Team with the most points at the end of the season wins.

Game Rules:

- Tee shots will start from designated tee boxes for all players
- A Gimmie circle of 3 feet will be set on all holes
 - Gimmies are awarded as +1. Example par 3, tee shot lands on the green within the gimmie circle a Birdie will be awarded.
- SINGLES matches can be played in any order
- No player can play more than two (2) SINGLES holes.

Registration & General Information:

- \$360.00 per Player per Season
- Digital Dunes will track game scores and match scores on our website/socials for all to see.
- Full season schedule and course being played will be defined before the season starts.
- Location dates and time will be defined before the season starts.
- Each team/player will need to pay in full before the season starts.
- Each team needs to register on Digital Dunes website
 - Team Name (profanity and derogatory content will not be accepted)
 - All team member names and emails are to be provided
 - Teams can have 3-5 players
